For this assignment you will work in teams of two or three. You will create a small web site that highlights the individuality of the team members.

The web sites should each have 2 pages per person plus a home page. A structural diagram is shown below. Each team member should have 2 pages, one featuring a short bio of the member and one featuring his or her “top 10” lists (with appropriate links).

Your first task is to create simple tab-style navigation. The tabs should have rounded edges and normal, selected, and hover states but use the methodology. Each tab should have a drop-down with the sub-menu items “All About Me” and “My Favorites”. The second task is to decide on a skinning scheme for each team member so that when the Team Member is selected, his or her skin appears. The skin should include, but not be limited to type styles (face/family, size, etc), colors, and placement. The home page should be an aggregation of both. The third task is to design the page(s). They can all be the same or all different but should convey some continuity, good usability and creativity.

You will have to use both CSS and Javascript to accomplish the tasks. Whether you choose to use a single page with content swaps, DOM swapping of CSS, or any method is up to you and your teammate.

You will have to drop your files at 9:30pm on Friday. For this portion, you will be graded up to 40 points and all team members will receive the same grade.

The following week you will present your web site to the class. You can opt to do adjustments or improvements. Your grade will be based on your ability to explain the processes that you used, as a team, to accomplish the web site. This includes both styling and scripting. You will be graded up to 10 points for your presentation and again, all team members will receive the same grade.
